



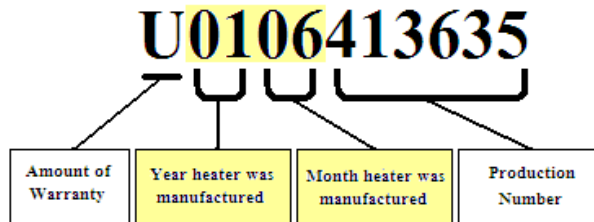
HOW OLD IS MY WATER HEATER? HOW TO READ OUR SERIAL NUMBERS

The first letter of the serial number represents the length of warranty on that heater "**Warranty Code**"

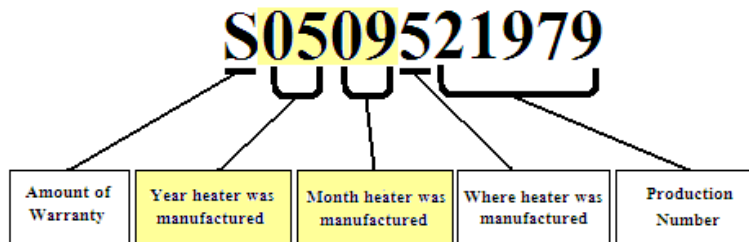
See Rating Label Serial Number prefix for Warranty Code. Reduced warranty period applies to Newfoundland.

Warranty Code:	P	R	S	T	U	V	W	Y
Standard Warranty Years:	3	5	6	7	8	9	10	12
Reduced Warranty Years:	3	3	3	5	5	5	5	7

1.) When looking at the serial number **prior to 2004** the serial numbers were read this way.

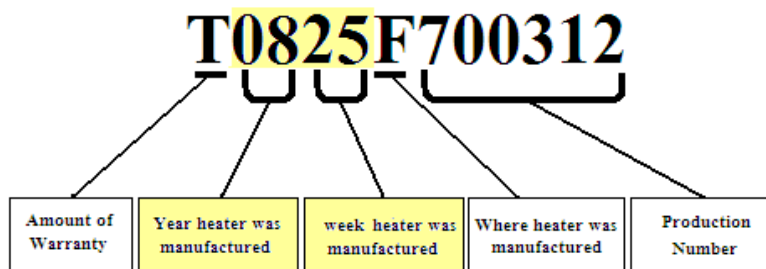


2.) **Between 2004 and 2007** the format for the serial numbers were read this way.



The 6th digit of the serial # represented the place of manufacture; **5**=Fergus and **1**=Johnson City

3.) **2008 and Later** The new format for the serial numbers was implemented
There is no longer a reduced warranty for Newfoundland.



The 5th digit of the serial number represents the place of manufacture:

A = Ashland City
N = Nanjing
F = Fergus
T = Johnson City

M = McBee
E = El Paso
S = Stratford

C = Charlotte
R = Renton
J = Juarez
